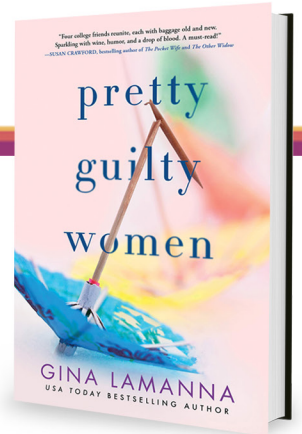

HIT THE BOOK CLUB WITH *PRETTY GUILTY WOMEN* BY GINA LAMANNA

2. Does that character still have it the best by the end? If not, who does?
3. When you first started the book, who did you think the victim was? Who did you think killed them?
4. At what point did you know for certain who the victim/killer was? What gave it away?
5. Were you surprised by the ending?
6. The Banks/LeBleu wedding redefines "extravagant," though these week-long destination weddings are becoming more and more popular among newlyweds. Do you think that these types of weddings are a grand celebration of their love or do they take away from the true meaning of the ceremony?
7. Have you been to a wedding like this one? What was it like?
8. If you were in Ginger's shoes, would you be able to forgive Emily for what she did to her in college?
9. What's the worst thing you've ever forgiven someone for?
10. At what point did you start to realize Sydney may be an integral part of the story?
11. Were you surprised at her connection to the crime and the women? Did you suspect she was connected to the story in a different way?
12. The story alternates between the viewpoints of four women. Is there another character you would have liked to hear perspective from but didn't?
